

### **ELECTRONIC DEVICES**

While we recognize that cell phones and personal music devices are very much a part of our lives today, and cell phones have useful applications which can support learning, they can also be very disruptive to learning. We remind students and parents that cell phones and personal devices are NOT permitted unless specifically requested by the teacher for an educational purpose. Please note that staff may temporarily confiscate these devices should they find them disruptive to learning and/or if used without permission. Also, we remind parents and students that sadly, the theft of cell phones and personal music devices sometimes happens. The school is not responsible for the theft or breakage of cell phones and personal music devices. We advise students and parents that these devices should be either left at home or in students' backpacks at all times, but off during the school day. School phones are available for all students to contact home should the need arise.

### Welcome to our new and returning Dixon families!
