We request that students who have been sick may return to school after they've been symptom free for at least 24 hours.

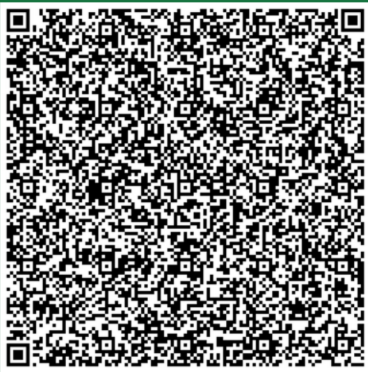
If a teacher or staff observes a student with new or worsening symptoms of illness, we may call home for the student to be picked up early.

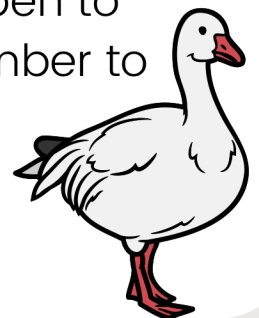

Coin Drive Nov 28 - Dec 2



Hello Everyone,

This year Student Council will be asking the Dixon School Community to work together to raise money for families in our community to make their holiday season merrier. On Monday, Nov. 28th, we will be kicking off this year's coin drive with Nickel Day, followed by Dime Day on Tuesday, Quarter Day on Wednesday, Loonie Day on Thursday, and Toonie Day on Friday Dec. 2. Students may bring smaller coins later in the week as well. Our coin drive goal for this year is to raise over \$1200... which is a lot of money, but we would get there if each student brought one of each coin.

To help promote the coin drive we will be asking Student Council members to visit each classroom. During their visit, they will talk to each class about the coin drive and explain why we are doing it (support families in need, give back to our community, and because we care about others). They will also be leaving a poster for you to display in your classroom, advertising the event. Parents will be informed through a school newsletter.

Finally, during the week of the coin drive student council will come around to each classroom first thing each morning to collect coins, which they will count at lunchtime. They will then post the results on the bulletin board in the front hallway and let the school know who is winning. For this event, there are two incentives: if the school makes our \$1200 goal, then willing staff will perform in a fashion show for the students, perhaps during the talent show in January. The class who raises the most money per student will get to dress up the staff!
