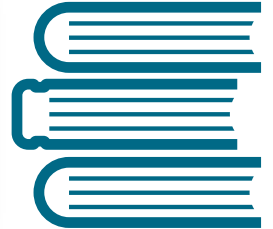

## Academic Completion

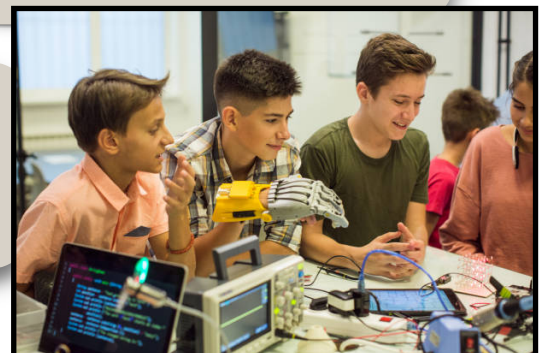
For students who received a course mark between 35%-49%, a letter grade "I" (incomplete) or "F" (fail)
